

### TeamMate 360:

## Exponential Training & Assessment:

Sally Bull, Sales Admin Manager, Orchard Toys

Sally used the results and responses of her T360 assessment to help her focus on the areas her colleagues felt were important.

#### **Summary**

TeamMate 360 has many uses – in this case study we take a look at how Sally has used it as part of her professional development and to help her become more effective in managing her team.

#### Challenges

In her role as Sales Admin Manager for Orchard Toys one of Sally's challenges is to manage the different personalities within her team so that they individually and collectively meet objectives. Asking for feedback from team members seemed daunting, however Sally recognised that it was essential if she was to develop her management and leadership skills.

#### T360 Assessment

TeamMate 360 has provided the opportunity for Sally to receive anonymous and confidential feedback from her colleagues and team members. This in turn allowed Sally to prioritise areas of development and plan specific actions in relation to managing teams.

#### The Outcome

Sally is working towards the Level 5
Certificate in Management and Leadership
qualification awarded by the Chartered
Management Institute. This, combined with
the TeamMate 360 assessment results,
means that she can focus on the skills
needed to become an effective team leader.

#### Results and Future Plans

Sally will undertake a repeat assessment in the future so that she can compare before and after results and discover the progress she has made in developing key skills.

Being able to compare her own perceptions of how she managed with those of others meant that Sally was able to explore reasons for any differences and make plans to bridge the gaps.
